



Mrs. Woolly's Campground Opens in Glenorchy

*Tenting, Campervan and "Glamping" Spots Fill Campsite Gap

Glenorchy, New Zealand, 14 December 2015 – To accommodate campers during the construction of the new NetZero Energy Camp Glenorchy, the owners of Mrs. Woolly's General Store (formerly General Store, Glenorchy) today announced the opening of Mrs. Woolly's Campground on the site of the old Glenorchy holiday park on Oban Street, providing an affordable option for casual overnight travelers visiting what locals call "the head of the lake, the heart of the mountains."

Offering 36 unpowered sites for tenting and campervans, the site also includes two "glamping" tents, outfitted with a king-size bed or two twins, linens, lighting, solar power, and coffee and fresh pastries delivered to your tent in the morning. Shared facilities for guests onsite include a fully equipped kitchen, BBQs, toilets, coin-operated showers and laundry, and a children's play area. As an added twist on campground services, upon check-in, order forms are available for ordering breakfast and hot coffee that can be delivered to guests' campsites the next morning. Campers can also pick up groceries, fresh takeaway foods, soap, and outdoor gear and supplies at Mrs. Woolly's General Store next door.

Prices for campsites are \$30 per site per night for two people, plus \$15 for each additional adult or \$10 for each extra child. Glamping tents are \$130 per night for two people, with a minimum stay of two nights. Bookings are recommended during December and January, especially for the weekend of Glenorchy Race Day, 2 January 2016.

Andrew Jeffery, a seasoned hospitality professional from Queenstown, has been hired as on-site manager. The campground will be open through 29 March 2016.
